

# Wh-Questions

When we report Wh-questions, we use 'Wh-question' and change the time and tense.

Direct Speech	Reported Speech
Peter asked her, "When are you coming back?"	Peter asked her <i>when she was coming back.</i>
My mother asked me, "Who are you talking to?"	My mother asked me <i>who I was talking to.</i>
